

Birthing is moving on Monday 26 August



Blacktown Hospital Birthing will be moving to the new Building A on Monday 26 August 2019. The new ward is called A62 Birthing.



Transfers will begin about 8.00am and we expect to be completed by lunchtime.



If it is safe to move you to the new building, you will be transferred to the new ward, with a clinical escort including a midwife.



Not all patients will move to the new building. Midwives will tell you if you are moving or going home, depending on your clinical needs. If you are going home on MOVE day, you will be discharged from the ward. Midwives will advise you.



Please send home any non-essential personal or valuable items before the MOVE.



Staff will pack and manage your medications, if you have any.



If your new room has carer accommodation, staff will explain the new system.



If you have any questions or concerns, please speak to a staff member on your ward.



Blacktown Hospital's new Building A includes units for Birthing, Newborn Care and Maternity.

These have been designed by our midwives and medical staff with the help of mums who have been patients in our hospital.

A62 Birthing

Birthing is located on level 6 of the new hospital building.

All birthing rooms are single rooms with birthing ropes and birthing ledges to support you in active labour. All rooms have an en-suite shower and toilet. Some rooms also have a birthing bath.

A71 Maternity

Maternity is located on level 7.

It includes single and double rooms, all with en-suites, and baby baths.

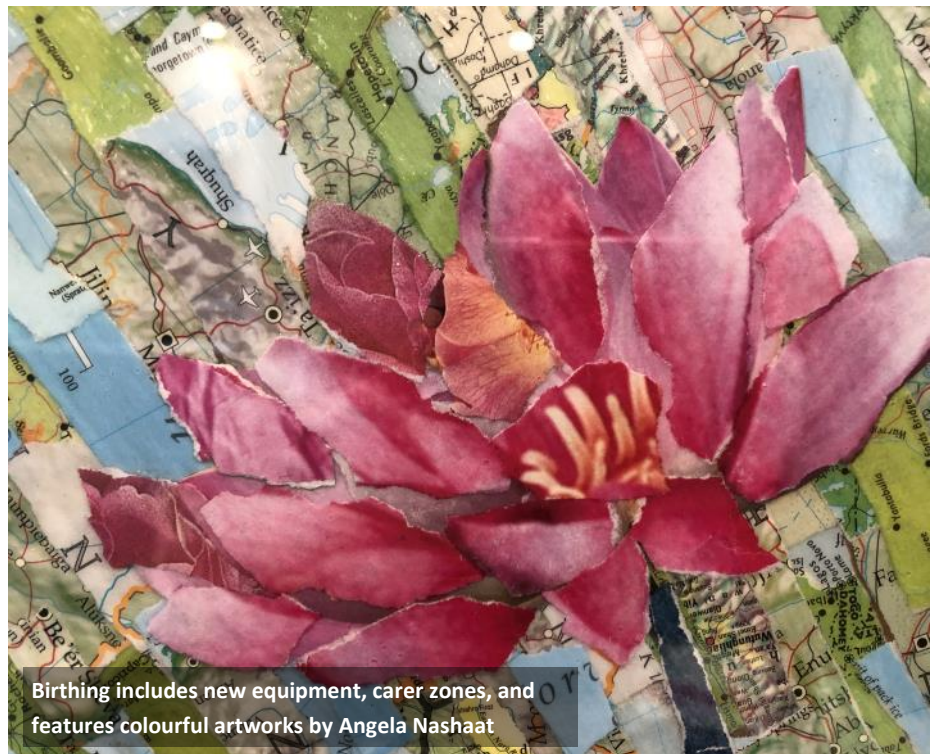
Single rooms have carer zones so your partner or support person can stay overnight with you.

There is also a courtyard and lounge area for mums, babies and visitors.

A61 Newborn Care

Newborn Care provides extra support for babies, and is located level 6.

Newborn Care includes spacious new rooms with room for a recliner next to your baby's cot, and amenities for parents.
