

## Newborn Care is moving on Monday 26 August



Blacktown Hospital Newborn Care will be moving to the new Building A on Monday 26 August 2019. The new ward is called A61 Newborn Care.



Transfers will begin about 10.00am and we expect to be completed by lunchtime.



Not all babies will move to the new building. Nursing staff will tell you if you are moving or going home. If you are going home on MOVE day, you will be discharged from the ward. Nursing staff will advise you.



If you are being transferred to the new ward, your baby will be moved with a clinical escort including a specialist midwife.



Please take home any non-essential personal or valuable items before the MOVE.



Staff will pack and manage your baby's medications.



If your new room has carer accommodation, staff will explain the new system.



If you have any questions or concerns, please speak to a staff member on your ward.

## A61 Newborn Care

**Newborn Care provides extra support for babies, and is located level 6.**

**Newborn Care includes spacious new rooms with room for a recliner next to your baby's cot, and amenities for parents.**

## A71 Maternity

**Maternity is located on level 7.**

**It includes single and double rooms, all with en-suites, and baby baths.**

**Single rooms have carer zones so your partner or support person can stay overnight with you.**

**There is a also courtyard and lounge area for mums, babies and visitors.**
